1- Read and agree to God's Pantry Volunteer Code of conduct

Promote a Respectful Community.

Treat all volunteers, employees and community members with respect, courtesy and dignity. Avoid insensitive or offensive language. Make efforts to understand and honor other's culture. Follow all rules and policies set forth by the leaders of the distribution.

Stay Safe

Follow the instructions of team leaders. View volunteer leaders as having the same authority as staff when staff are not present.

Model Respectful Behavior

Model behavior that respects the human rights of all people and protects others from exploitation and abuse. Avoid inappropriate physical or sexual advances with other volunteers, staff and community members or using offensive language or behavior. The distributions are not a place to try to sell, promote or recruit for your business or non-associated organization. Any of the aforementioned behavior may be grounds for removal.

Maintain Confidentiality

Maintain and respect the confidentiality of volunteers, staff, guests and community members. We do not collect information of our guest beyond what is required by the policies of the distribution centers, and do not share this information with any third party.
